*Oriental college of Education and Research organized the Student council election on 8th July 2021 for the student volunteers and encouraged them to come forward and embrace the opportunity to*



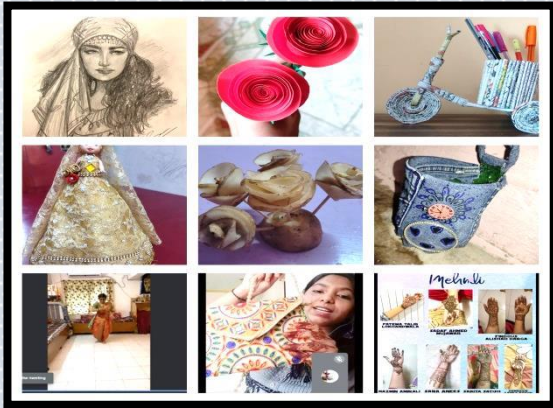

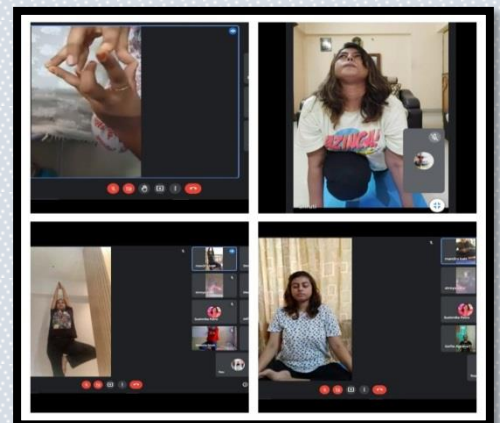

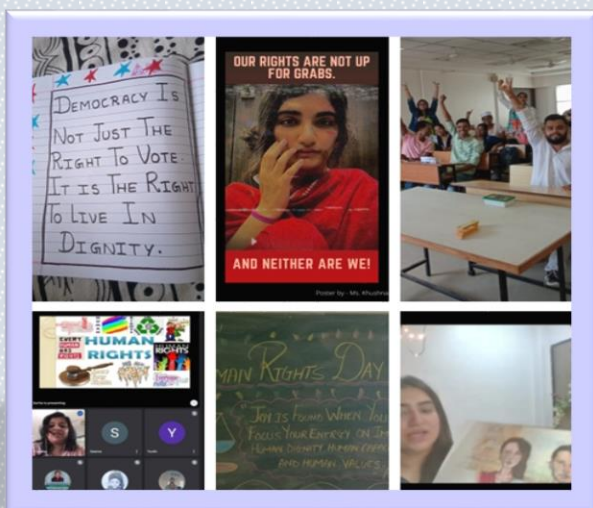
## ***CHILDREN DAY CELEBRATION***

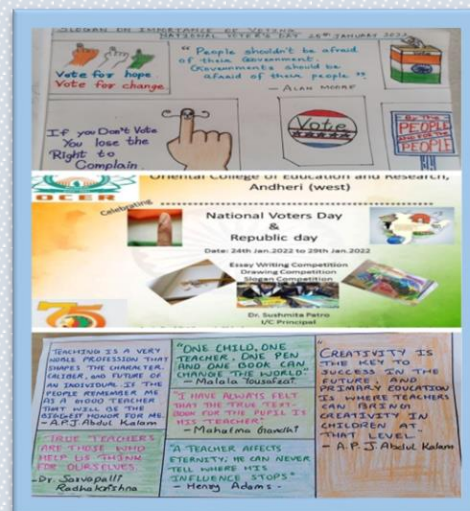


*participated in the competition and each was awarded with the certificate as a token of appreciation. The day was filled with enthusiasm, enjoyment and enchantment.*

### Orientation program- B.Ed. Sem- I Batch 2021 - 23

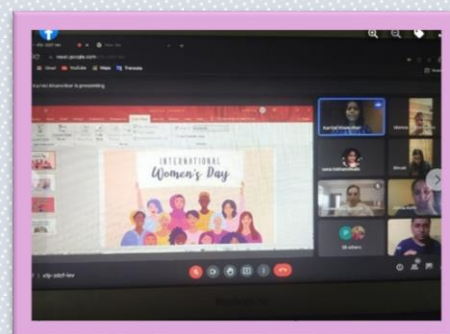
