Workshop on Lesson Plan writing

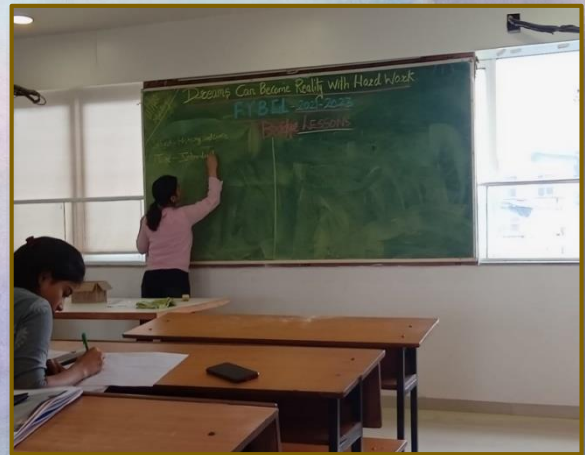
Workshop on Lesson Plan writing was conducted in OCER by Assistant Prof Rupali Wadkar, Veena Kasabe, Manisha

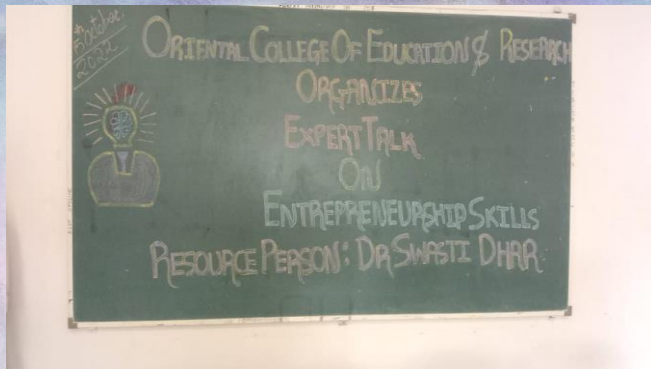
Eid Celebration

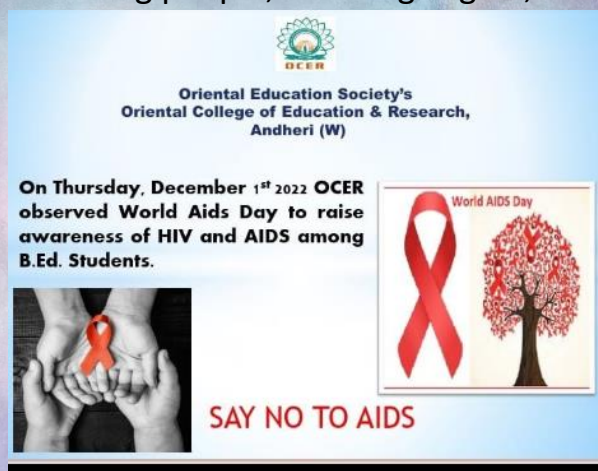
International Men Day

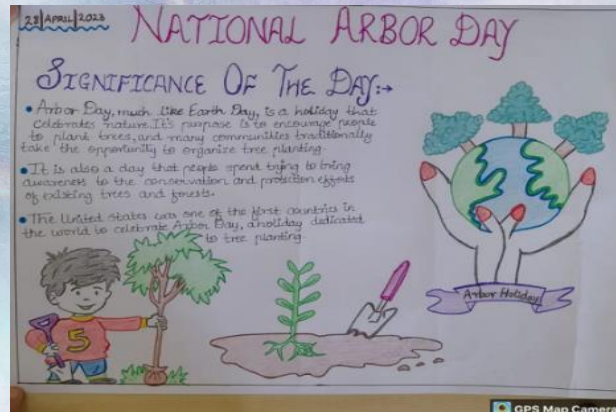
Eid Celebration

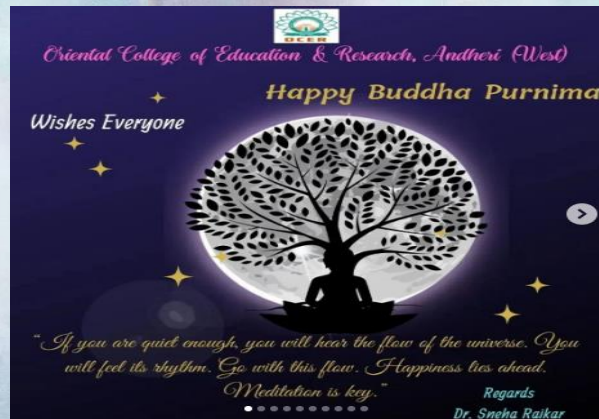
Maharashtra Day & Labor Day

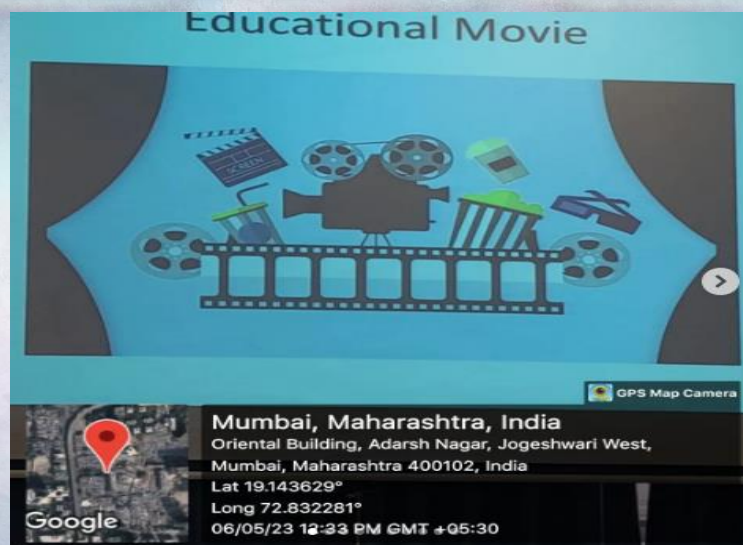

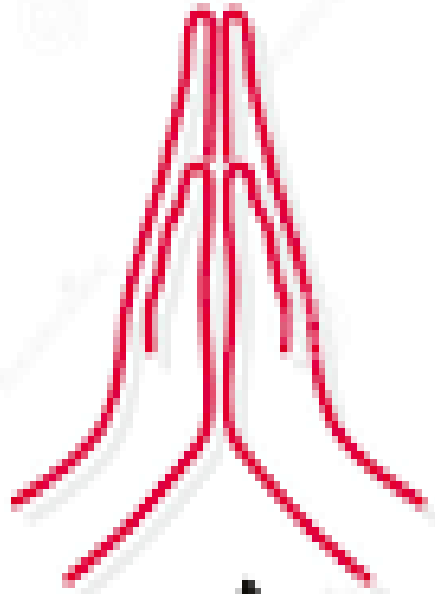
