

OCER we celebrated Onam on 29th August 2023, where the special assembly was conducted by the students and the significance was told why Onam is celebrated??




Teacher's Day Celebration

International Day of the Girl Child






On 11th October at OCER we celebrated the

October. The idea is to promote across the world the awareness about disaster deduction and risk awareness which is extremely important to save lives and to save the world.




E - Warte Day


Every year, 18th October is observed as Unity Day or




Christmas Celebration


Ram Lalla Pran Prathistha

Free Eye Check Up



This article states that "the elections to the House of the People and to the Legislative Assembly of every State shall be on the basis of adult suffrage; that is to say, every person who is a citizen of India and who is not less than 18 years of age on such date as may be fixed in that behalf by or under any law made by the appropriate Legislature and is not otherwise disqualified under this Constitution or any law made by the appropriate Legislature on the ground of nonresidence, unsoundness of mind, crime or corrupt or illegal practices, shall be entitled to be registered as a voter at any such election." 






World Blood Donor


