Program Highlights:

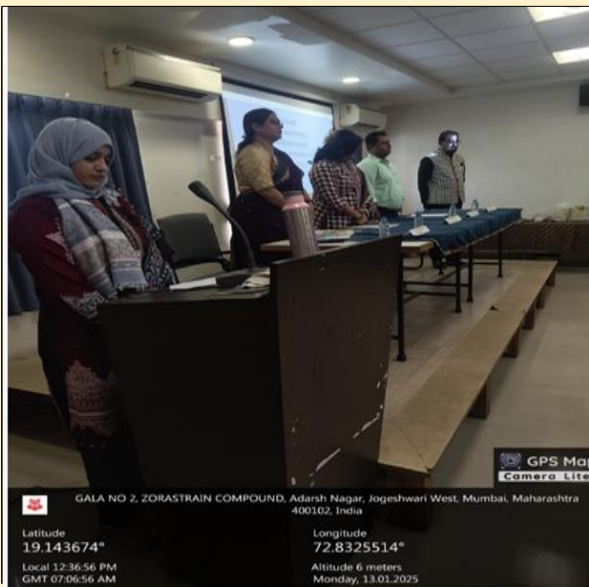
