With a heartfelt commitment to quality education, OCER's strategic plan for 2025-2030 is designed to foster excellence in academic and research endeavors, ensure deep-rooted value-based education, build meaningful industry and community collaborations, and ensure holistic faculty development. This document presents our pathway for the next five years, blending aspiration with actionable goals.

Strategic Goals

1. Academic Excellence

- Curriculum modernization and integration of emerging technologies.
- Certificate programs on leadership, digital pedagogy, and educational psychology.

2. Research and Publication Focus

- Fully Functional OCER Research and Innovation Cell.
- Launch peer-reviewed OCER Research Journal.
- Annual Research Conferences (National Level).

3. Innovative Tryouts in Teaching-Learning Process

- Pilot and evaluate technology-enabled, learner-centric teaching methods across diverse courses to enhance student engagement and learning outcomes.
- Encourage faculty to experiment with creative pedagogical tools such as flipped classrooms, gamification, and collaborative online platforms, supported by institutional grants.

• Document and share best practices and outcomes of innovative teaching approaches through workshops, seminars, and internal publications to foster a culture of continuous improvement.

4. Value-Based Education

- Implement Value Education Across Curriculum (VEAC).
- Service-learning and community outreach as compulsory components.

5. Faculty Development

- Regular Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) on research skills, pedagogy, and digital innovation.
- Encourage faculty participation in national-level seminars, MOOCs, and conferences.

6. Alumni Engagement

- Register the OCER Alumni Association under the Society Registration Act.
- Build an active alumni network to support mentorship, fundraising, and career development initiatives.
- Organize annual alumni meetups, lectures, and collaborative projects.

- Organize programs and campaigns aligned with national priorities such as Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Digital India, Fit India Movement, Yoga and Meditation, Gender equality, HIV AND Cancer awareness programs and NEP 2020 awareness.

Short-Term (1-2 Years)

- **Innovative Tryouts in Teaching-Learning Process:** Pilot technology-enabled, learnercentric teaching methods in select courses and gather feedback to assess student engagement and learning effectiveness.
- Value-Based Education: Integrate VEAC into lesson planning; pilot service-learning modules.
- Faculty Development: Conduct quarterly FDPs; encourage MOOCs.
- Alumni Engagement: Register OCER Alumni Association; initiate outreach.
- National Priority Programs: Organize awareness campaigns (Swachh Bharat, Fit India, NEP 2020).
- **Outreach Activities:** Hold health camps, literacy drives, and skill workshops.
- Digital Infrastructure: Audit infrastructure; start student digital literacy workshops.
