Objectives of the Internship

1. To provide hands-on teaching experience in real classroom settings.
2. To enable students to apply theoretical knowledge and psychological principles during teaching.
3. To develop observation and reflective thinking through peer and mentor-led teaching experiences.
4. To enhance pedagogical skills through planning and execution of subject-specific lessons.
5. To expose student-teachers to the day-to-day functioning and administrative environment of schools.
6. To participate in or observe co-curricular, cultural, and institutional activities of the school.
7. To promote professional attitudes, classroom management skills, and ethical responsibilities in future teachers.
8. To foster collaboration, teamwork, and interpersonal communication through peer learning and interaction with school staff.

Key Internship Components

1. Peer Observations

- Each student observed 5 lessons conducted by peers.
- Observations included classroom management, teaching aids, content delivery, and learner engagement.

2. Shadowing Teachers

- Each student shadowed experienced school teachers for 5 periods.
- Focused on understanding teaching styles, learner behavior, time management, and teacher responsibilities.

3. Individual Pedagogy Lessons

- Each student conducted 5 lessons using **Method 1 (Pedagogy I)**.
- Lesson plans aligned with school syllabus and psychological principles.
- Supervisors/mentors provided written feedback for improvement.

4. School Activities (Conducted or Observed)

- Minimum of 3 school-level activities (e.g., morning assembly, science exhibition, sports event, health check-up camp, etc.) were either observed or facilitated by student-teachers.
- Reflections and documentation were maintained.

5. Reflective Journal Writing

- All 62 students maintained a **15-day daily reflection journal**.
- Entries included lesson reflections, student responses, classroom incidents, emotional insights, and self-evaluation.

Outcomes of the Internship


- Students developed confidence in managing real classroom environments.
- There was evident improvement in lesson planning, time management, and child-centric teaching practices.
- Students were able to apply psychological and pedagogical theories in actual classroom situations.
- Exposure to school culture enhanced their understanding of the teaching profession beyond academics.
- Reflective writing deepened students' critical thinking, self-awareness, and professional identity.


