### **Conclusion:**

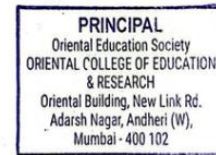

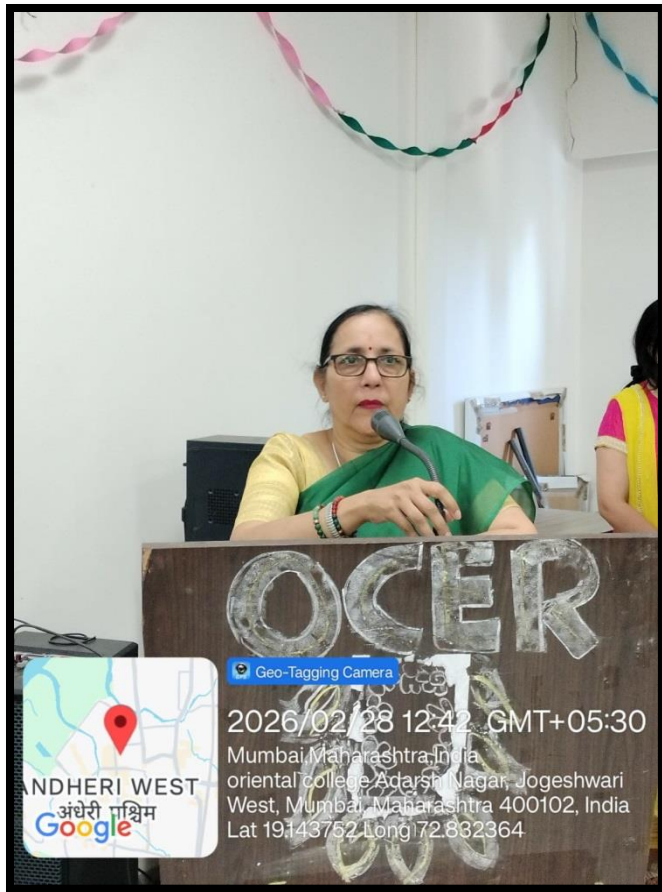
