The programme concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing heartfelt gratitude to the speaker for her valuable guidance and contribution.

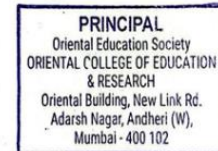
### **Conclusion:**
